**OPENING:** Interested and qualified persons are invited to apply for a full time (1.0 FTE) Special Education Teacher opening at Lake Tapps Elementary School beginning September 2018. This person will provide special education services to students in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades. Some students may have high needs and/or be on the autism spectrum. Paraeducators and related services staff members are part of the team to ensure a well-rounded program is in place for our special needs students.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. WA State Teaching Certificate with special education endorsement
2. Experience in educating students with special needs
3. Knowledge of Federal and State special education laws
4. Ability to write and implement IEPs
5. Strong understanding of data collection and management systems
6. Able to utilize multiple behavior management strategies
7. Training in prevention/de-escalation techniques, i.e. Right Response, Mandt, CPI
8. Able to lift 60 pounds

1. Write, train staff on, and implement effective programming for special education students
2. Provide for individual learning and behavioral needs of special education students and report progress to parents
3. Participate in training activities as required by building principal and/or special education director
